Springwell Learning Community has adapted to the increasing need for remote learning and strives to provide a bespoke learning offer which mirrors the curriculum accessed within school whilst meeting the individual needs of our learners.

Remote learning offer

The remote learning offer will be differentiated according to pupil need and may include:

- Live taught sessions via google Meet and the online platform Bramble
- Work tasks set and shared through Seesaw
- Website links to school programmes
- Printed resource packs

Communication

In order to maintain lines of communication, we will:

- Make daily contact with each pupil via Bramble
- Leave comments, provide support and give feedback on Seesaw activities.
- Speak to our families on the phone
- Make socially distanced home visits where appropriate.

If you are having difficulty accessing online resources please contact school so we are able to support you with this.

How much work will be set?

In the event of a whole or partial closure, our remote learning offer reflects the in-school curriculum. Work will be set in line with government guidelines. Our offer is differentiated by key stage and individual need. Primary age pupils will receive a remote learning offer equivalent to 3 hours of 'home' learning. Secondary age pupils will receive a remote learning offer equivalent to 4 hours of 'home' learning.

How will work be shared?

Online platforms can be accessed in the following ways:

- One click links to Bramble will be sent via text and email
- All additional online learning will be shared via Seesaw

What support is available?

We recognise that some pupils may not be able to access some parts of our remote learning offer. While all work is differentiated, we acknowledge the difficulties this may place on families. The school is here to support and will be in regular contact to check how things are going at home.
